AIRCRAFT CRASH AT KAPAR, SELANGOR

PUTRAJAYA – The Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) confirms that a light aircraft model BK 160 Gabriel, registration number I-POOC, crashed near Kapar, Selangor on Tuesday, 13th February 2024. The aircraft operated by Air Adventure Flying Club departed from Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport, Subang, Selangor at 1:28pm for recreational flight.

Last contact made by the aircraft with air traffic control was at 1:35pm, however, there was no distress call received. Kuala Lumpur Aeronautical Rescue Coordination Centre (KLARCC) at Kuala Lumpur Air Traffic Control Centre (KLATCC) was immediately activated to determine the location of the aircraft.

A total of two persons including one pilot were onboard and their conditions have yet to be confirmed at press time. The safety investigation will be conducted by the Air Accident Investigation Bureau under the Ministry of Transport Malaysia in accordance with Part XXVI of the Civil Aviation Regulations 2016.
